Multilateralism in the New Cold War

Frank Vibert, London School of Economics, UK

In elegant, jargon-free prose it outlines a pathway out of an existential problem of our digital age – the increasing difficulty in fully-multilateral bodies to reach agreement on how to manage global problems. 


