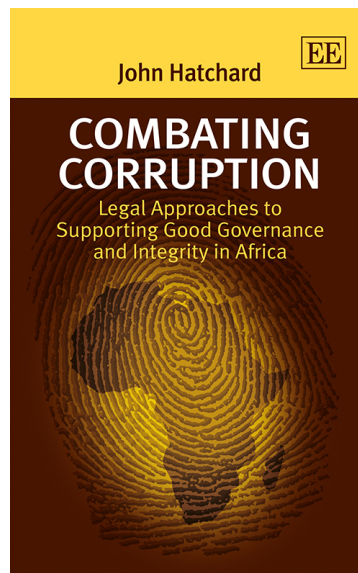
Legal Approaches to Supporting Good Governance and Integrity in Africa
