

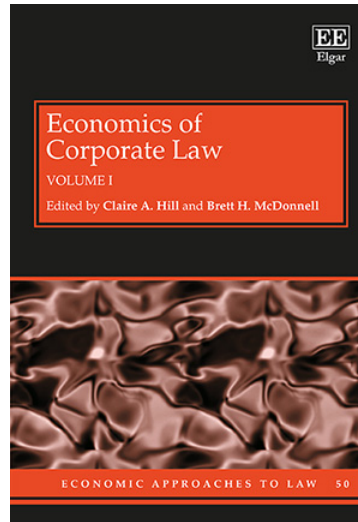


Economics of Corporate Law
