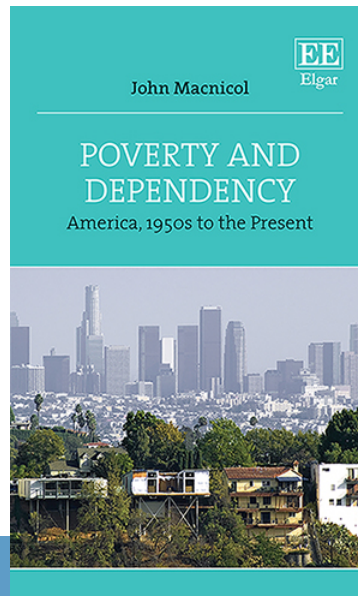




Poverty and Dependency America, 1950s to the Present
