



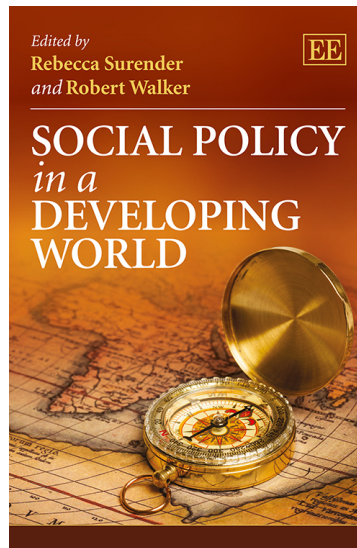
Social Policy in a Developing World
