

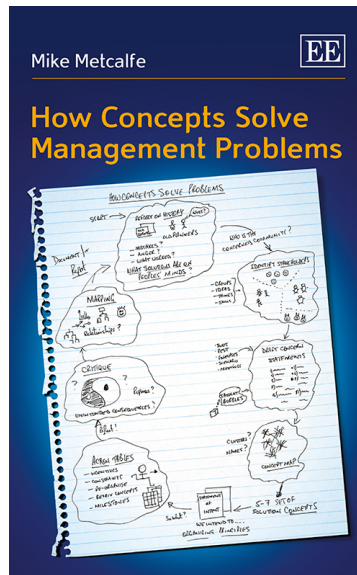


How Concepts Solve Management Problems
