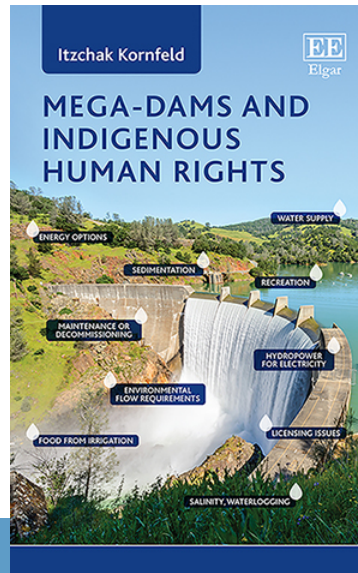




Mega-Dams and Indigenous Human Rights
