

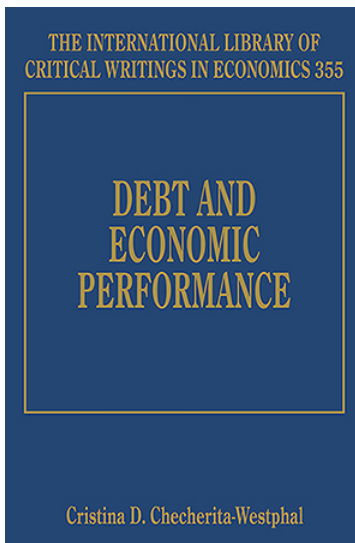


Debt and Economic Performance
