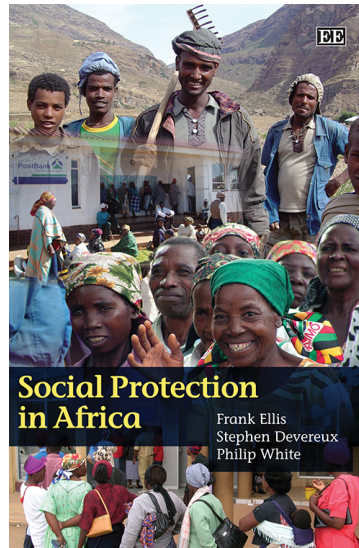




Social Protection in Africa
